

iMBRA Rule Amendments - January 2024

The iMBRA Committee released a new version of the iMBRA General Rules, valid from 1 January 2024. This document is listing the new or amended sections. Besides checking this list, please make sure you also read the exact new rules in the rule book.

Changes in the iMBRA General Rules, as of January 2024

New nitro rule:

Section 3.3.2: all the details of the new nitro limitation, 16% (weight) or approx. 12% (volume)

New Stock Zenoah 26 class:

Section 2.1: Endurance Stock Zenoah 26 class added

Section 2.3: Offshore Stock Zenoah 26 class added

Section 3.2.1: Stock Zenoah classes also allowed for juniors aged 12 years or above

Section 11 (new separate document): Stock Zenoah 26 Regulations (Endurance and Offshore)

Other rules:

Section 3.3.3 / 5) and 3.4.4 / 1) Transponder numbers need to be written on the boats

Section 3.4.2 / 20) Driving from the competitor's own raised platform (e.g. stool or box) NOT allowed (both for juniors and seniors)

Section 3.4.3 / 2) A boat is only allowed to race in 1 class (e.g. a 27cc boat cannot be raced in the 35cc class at the same competition)

Section 12 (new separate document): iMBRA League rules (unchanged) and new World Ranking rules
